THE DESK PROCESS



1. Bleacher Wood Donation

Know a school who is transitioning out wooden bleachers? Donating the bleacher wood could save an organization upwards of \$15,000.





3. Desk Assembly

Volunteers assemble the prepared pieces into desks. The desks are checked for quality (no wobbly desks allowed!), and then the pieces are labeled for easy re-assembly. Then, the desks have to be taken apart for shipping. Each desk is polyurethaned, and then individually wrapped with all the pieces necessary for one desk.



2. Wood Preparation

Once the wood arrives at Midwest Mission, volunteers scrape the gum off (seriously!), remove any metal pieces, and plane, sand, and cut the pieces to size.









4. Distribution

Students around the world are able to enjoy the hard work of our volunteers. They have a clean, hard surface to work on, providing a more functional learning environment.
